As you are aware the Public Spaces Protection Order for Dog Control is now in place. There are a number of offences within the order including no dog areas, dogs on leads and the main one being no dog fouling.

The council has procured a limited quantity of signs that can be erected around the county in the hot spot areas where dog fouling is prevalent such as open spaces, footpaths etc. but also attached to this email is the printable version of the dog fouling sign so you could print off /laminate and display as well.

Arrangements are being made for the no dog area (mainly children's enclosed play areas) signs to be put up along with the dogs on leads signs.

To try and get the dog fouling signs out across the county we need assistance from the parish and town councils in locating the hot spots and putting the signs up.
