## 10.0 Planning Application

**10.1** Planning Application 230357 Land at Wormbridge (both sides of A465) North of the Abbeydore Road Hybrid planning application; Outline with all matters included except landscaping, for 70 new dwellings, new flexible workspace (Class E) and replacement childcare facility.

Full Planning for the change of use of existing schoolhouse to residential and change of use of existing dwelling to a community facility (Class E, F1, and F2) and associated infrastructure

Proposed by Councillor Mr N Eynon and Seconded by Councillor Mr M Parsons Vice-Chairman

Whitfield Estate are holding an Open Day on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2023

Kilpeck Parish Council considered Planning Consultation No 230357 Land at Wormbridge at their meeting held on the 13<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

The Parish Council resolved unanimously to support the application with the proviso that the following issues be addressed.

- 1) The creation of a pedestrian footway from the A465 on the C1212 to the new development site be included
- 2) A 30mph limit zone be created on the C1212 prior to the development entrance
- 3) The C1212 splay onto the A465 requires re-designing due to an issue for either large commercial or agricultural vehicles attempting to enter the junction from the South.
  - If there is a vehicle waiting to exit the C1212 onto the A465 the splay is not wide enough to allow for large vehicles to enter, which creates the situation of a large vehicle stationary on the A465 waiting to enter the C1212 which in turn obstructs the visibility to the South for the exiting vehicle.
- 4) The culvert under the C1212 near the junction with the A465 requires upgrading as it already floods during wet weather and the additional development site runoff will only increase the volume of water through this system.
- 5) The proposed commercial site development surface water runoff, feeds into a drainage system which passes through the Wormbridge Church area, a survey should be undertaken to make sure that Wormbridge Church is not put at any risk from the additional water runoff.
